Organization	Presentation is well organized, logical, intelligent and shows a great deal of preparation.	Presentation is organized, logical, intelligent and shows adequate preparation.	Presentation shows signs of organization, but lacks clarity, with a fair amount of preparation.	Presentation shows poor organization and lack of preparation.
Content (Cause)	Accurately sequences 4 or more causes of the confrontation with clear description of cause and effect.	Sequences 3 causes of the confrontation with some description of cause and effect.	Sequences fewer than 3 causes of the confrontation with limited description of cause and effect.	No sequence of causes shown with limited description.
Content (Analysis)	Clearly identifies event as a massacre or a riot with 4 or more suitable reasons to support the choice.	Clearly identifies event as a massacre or a riot with 3 suitable reasons to support the choice.	Identifies event as a massacre or a riot with limited support.	Does not identify event as massacre or riot.
Format/Delivery	Excellent use of aids (images, quotes, timeline, etc); all support the topic.	Good use of aids and support materials; almost all support the topic.	Adequate use of aids and support materials; most support the topic.	Poor use of aids and support materials; does not support the topic.
